The workshop will be held at the USAL University in Buenos Aires City and in Villa Mascardi, near San Carlos de Bariloche, in North Patagonia.

Travel:

The first two days will take place in Buenos Aires City at the USAL University for the presentation and launch of the WS.

The following six days the WS moved to Villa Mascardi near San Carlos de Bariloche in the province of Rio Negro. The town of Villa Mascardi can be reached by a two-hour flight from Buenos Aires or a 24-hour bus journey.

The closing of the WS will always take place in Buenos Aires in the last two days at the USAL University.

Architectural Design theme:

It's about a Land Art Project Workshop which will be located in the Río Manso-Lago Mascardi basin, where the USAL property is located, and the theme will be: a new nucleus of services, equipment and infrastructure for the development of the "Camping Musical Mascardi", as an enclave to hold musical gatherings based on sound experiences typical of the lacustrine environment; following the tradition of Camping Musical Bariloche, with 70 years of history. The location area includes the current La Querencia I private campsite, the mallín or wetland at the mouth of the Yacondo River and the property of the cabins of the Universidad del Salvador, on the shores of Mascardi Lake.

General information about Villa Mascardi:

The town is considered as a rural population. The hull is made up of houses, a pantry, a detachment of the Río Negro Police and a public school. On the outskirts of the town there is a Park Ranger office, an "ACA" service station and 4 accommodations: Hotel Mascardi (Closed since 2009), Hotel Gas del Estado (Closed since 1992), and the two open ones are the Hotel Tronador

(private) and the Hueche Ruca Cabins of the Bishopric of San Isidro founded in 1962 by Father Aníbal Coerezza, where Scout groups and different parochial schools stay. In the months of November and December the meadows that surround it are dressed in colors with the flowers of lupines.

Who can participate?

Students attending the fifth year of the five-year course, second year of Master degree. The minimum number of participants accepted is 10 students.

Thesis:

Interested students will be able to continue the workshop theme with their graduation theses, if necessary, by taking advantage of scholarships for student mobility with the USAL, provided by Sapienza.

Credits:

Four credits for extracurricular activities will be attributed to the participants.

Costs and organization:

- The workshop registration fee is 500 €. For payment, contact attilia.derose@uniroma1.it
- Flights from Buenos Aires to San Carlos de Bariloche / San Carlos de Bariloche to Buenos Aires: (from €130 to €200) or a 24-hour bus journey (€170)
- Accommodation for 6 nights in USAL Cabins in Villa Mascardi: 30€ per night per person.
- Food for 6 days in the USAL Cabins: €45 per day (includes breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- Right of access to the Nahuel Huapi National Park for foreigners for 6 days: €20.
- The cost of private bus trips for the local sections San Carlos de Bariloche Villa Mascardi is not included.
